## Program Language

All courses through Cape Town are taught in English, except for language instruction courses.

## **General Transfer Information**

Please note that students must take the equivalent of a full time course load (12 credits minimum) when studying abroad to qualify for financial aid.

16 Credits through Cape Town are equivalent to 16 semester credits at St. Norbert College.

If a student receives a grade of C- (53%) Third Class or lower, then the student will not earn credit for that course. It will count as credits attempted, not earned, and will be reflected on the student's St. Norbert transcript as NT (Not Transferable).

All courses passed while abroad transfer with a grade of **T (Transferable)**. Students do not receive the SNC equivalent grade and Cape Town grades are not factored into the student's GPA. The SNC grade equivalency is provided as a courtesy for the student to better understand the minimum grade required to earn transfer credit.
