Program Language

Courses taught at Montpellier are primarily taught in French. Courses taught in English cannot transfer as French electives.

General Transfer Information

Please note that students must take the equivalent of a full time course load (12 credits minimum) when studying abroad to qualify for financial aid.

15 Units at Montpellier are equivalent to 15 semester credits at St. Norbert College.

Students at Montpellier will be awarded 1 additional credit if they pass the equivalent of 15 St. Norbert College semester credits.

If a student receives a grade of **C- (10.5/6.5)** or lower, then the student will not earn credit for that course. It will count as credits attempted, not earned, and will be reflected on the student's St. Norbert transcript as **NT (Not Transferable)**.

All courses passed while abroad transfer with a grade of **T (Transferable)**. Students do not receive the SNC equivalent grade and Montpellier grades are not factored into the student's GPA. The SNC grade equivalency is provided as a courtesy for the student to better understand the minimum grade required to earn transfer credit.
